It is also helpful for us to review your student's most recent report card, transcript, and/or standardized testing scores to provide additional context, so please upload these as well.

At the enrollment appointment, we will discuss your child's appropriate academic course placement (considering teacher recommendations, supplemental academic record information, and Pope teacher recommended grade criteria) and elective selections at this appointment. <u>Instructions for Core Recommendations:</u>

Please ask your student's current Middle School teachers to initial next to their recommendation for the appropriate subject area below. If you wish to have your student take a different class than what is recommended, we will discuss this during the enrollment appointment. Waivers may be required to move a student to a higher level. Courses are considered year-long commitments and changes are not made mid-year.

*World/Human Geography is considered an "academic elective" and is not a specified Social Studies graduation requirement. The majority of our students choose to take a course from each core subject area each year and World/Human Geography (onlevel, honors, or AP) is highly recommended both for college preparation and to provide background/context for future social studies courses.

**World Language classes are considered "academic electives;" however most 4-year colleges and some 2-year colleges require at least 2 years of the same language for admission. Taking more is recommended for competitive college admission, if academically appropriate for your student. For this reason, we highly recommend students complete at least 2 years before graduation. If students are not currently enrolled in a language in middle school or if they wish to switch to a different language, they can opt to start at level 1 of any of the offered languages in 9th grade or start a language during a later school year. Recommendations for Level 2 require that the student provide evidence of completion of Level 1 of the same language in middle school provided that the course is considered to be high school level content.
