POPE DUAL ENROLLMENT DEADLINES

Pope sets an internal priority deadline that is **EARLIER** than the college deadlines and the CCSD DE deadline of May 1. Applying earlier provides students a better* chance of getting desired courses/locations/times. *Disclaimer: We cannot guarantee acceptances within a specific timeframe, nor desired times or locations of DE classes.

The Pope Priority Deadline is:

If the college DE deadline is earlier, we strongly recommend completing the process AT LEAST ONE MONTH PRIOR to that deadline.

| | Attend the CCSD Dual Enrollment (DE) Summit General Information Session AND the Pope Session OR watch the replay videos of each at http://bit.ly/PopeDEPage . This is mandatory for both families and students interested in DE. Additional meetings, such as College Information Sessions, do not replace this requirement but serve as supplements to the CCSD/Pope specific information. |
| | Research fit of DE to your situation - for example, check admission requirements both for DE and college admissions, impact to GPA/HOPE, DE vs. AP, day-to-day logistics, driving/parking, course transferability, etc. |
| | Take the SAT/ACT/Accuplacer and submit scores (and any desired AP scores) to the college ASAP. Registration and submission information can be found for each at: SAT and AP: www.collegeboard.org ACT: www.actstudent.org Accuplacer: schedule directly with Chatt Tech Send AP scores ASAP to exempt intro courses FALL testing strongly recommended to meet Pope Priority Deadline! |
| | Submit the college's DE application (found on college website). |
| | Submit official HS transcript to college (\$2). Student - request in the counseling office after applying to the college (Chattahoochee Tech does not require a transcript for admission) |
| | Submit DE funding application on www.gafutures.org (both Student and Parent must sign) |
| | Complete CCSD DE School Agreement, available on http://bit.ly/PopeDEPage and email this to counselor to request a Counselor DE Advisement Meeting. We will respond with some follow-up items to complete/prepare and submit to us prior to the meeting. Please plan far enough in advance so that this meeting can be arranged prior to March 1. We will discuss graduation requirements, desired DE classes, complete an Advisement form, and more. We reserve the right to reschedule the meeting if steps above are not completed before the meeting. |

| | Receive an emailed admission decision from college (~2-6 weeks). Register for and attend advisement/orientation at college ASAP Receive an emailed admission decision from college (~2-6 weeks). Completed prior to the Pope Priority Deadline of March 1. |
| | Register for classes through student's college registration portal ASAP. |
| | Email a PDF of your detailed schedule to your counselor ASAP, but no later than the last day of school. |

Send any remaining documents to college (immunization, verification of lawful presence, etc.).

Pope sets INTERNAL DEADLINES for full college application submission AND a completed Counselor Advisement Meeting.

The Pope Priority deadline is: MARCH 1

If the college DE deadline is earlier, we strongly recommend completing the process AT LEAST ONE MONTH PRIOR to that deadline. While the CCSD Deadline is May 1, which is allowable, we strongly urge you to abide by the Pope Priority Deadline.
